

1st Dhil Hijjah

- Pilgrims from various parts of India and around the world arrive in Dubai at least one day before the departure to Madinah on 1st Dhil Hijjah.
- On 1st Dhil Hijjah, all pilgrims assemble at Dubai International Airport for group processing.
- Pilgrims travel from Dubai to Madinah on a direct Saudia Airlines flight, accompanied by a group leader who oversees every 50 pilgrims.
- Upon arrival at Madinah Airport, pilgrims are transported by bus to their designated hotel in Madinah.
- Hotel check-in and baggage assistance are provided promptly to ensure a smooth arrival process.
- Pilgrims are escorted in groups to Masjid al-Nabawi for the first visit, with separate entry and exit routes arranged for men and women to enable future independent visits.
- The group is shown important sites including the Prophet's Home and other significant locations within the mosque complex.
- After the guided visit, pilgrims are given time to rest and acclimate at the hotel.

2nd Dhil Hijjah

- Male pilgrims are instructed to gather after Fajr prayer to offer Salaam to the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH).
- Following this, male pilgrims proceed to visit Jannatul Baqi for prayers and reflection.
- After the visit, breakfast is served to all pilgrims.
- All pilgrims then perform the remaining four daily prayers at Masjid al-Nabawi within the mosque premises.
- Both male and female pilgrims are guided to visit Riyaz ul Jannah according to their booking schedule.
- The visits to Riyaz ul Jannah are conducted either in groups or individually through the NUSUK system, strictly adhering to the guidelines established by the Saudi authorities.
- After completing the visits, pilgrims return for rest and recuperation at their accommodation

3rd Dhil Hijjah

- After Fajr prayer and breakfast, all pilgrims proceed for the Madinah Ziarath (Islamic City Sightseeing) tour.
- Pilgrims are advised to perform wudhu (ablution) before boarding the bus, as this act holds the reward equivalent to performing one Umrah.
- During the tour, pilgrims perform two rakat Salah at Masjid Quba, the first mosque established in Islamic history.
- The sightseeing includes visits to significant sites in Madinah such as:
 - Masjid Quba
 - Masjid al-Qiblatain (Mosque of the Two Qiblahs)
 - Uhud Mountain and the Battle of Uhud site
 - Jannatul Baqi (Historic Islamic Cemetery)
 - Surroundings of Masjid an-Nabawi for guided viewing
- The tour concludes before Zuhr prayer, following which pilgrims return to the hotel for lunch and rest.
- The remainder of the day is reserved for prayers, dinner, and light personal activities.
- Pilgrims may engage in individual light shopping as per their needs.
- All pilgrims are requested to complete packing their luggage in preparation for departure to Makkah the next day.

4th Dhil Hijjah

- Pilgrims are advised to place their bags outside their rooms before Fajr prayer, preferably the night before.
- Pilgrims are requested to perform Ghusl (full bath) prior to Fajr prayer.
- After Fajr prayer, pilgrims don ihram garments and wait for instructions regarding bus departure times as scheduled by Saudi authorities.
- Pilgrims are transported to Masjid Dhul Hulaifah (Meeqat of Madinah), the historic site where the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) assumed ihram.
- At Masjid Dhul Hulaifah, pilgrims perform two rakats of Salah and make the niyyah (intention) for Umrah or Hajj.
- Subsequently, pilgrims are taken to the Haramain Station to board transportation to Makkah.
- Upon arrival in Makkah, pilgrims are transferred by bus to their designated hotel.
- Assistance is provided for hotel check-in and baggage handling to ensure a smooth arrival.
- After dinner and Isha prayer, pilgrims are instructed to gather at a designated location to perform Umrah in groups.
- Each group of 50 pilgrims is led by an appointed Group Leader who guides them through the Umrah rituals.
- Following completion of Umrah, pilgrims return to their rooms to rest and recuperate.





5th to 7th Dhil Hijjah

- From 5th to 7th Dhil Hijjah, pilgrims are advised to perform all their prayers at Masjid al-Haram.
- Pilgrims should focus on consuming good quality food, ensuring adequate rest and sleep to maintain physical readiness for Hajj rituals.
- If in good health, pilgrims may perform additional Tawaf and Umrah during this period.
- Basic shopping for any essential items is permitted as needed.
- The primary focus during these days is on rest and worship (ibadah) to prepare mentally and physically for the upcoming Hajj rites.
- Pilgrims will be provided with a basic packing list to help prepare their luggage for the departure to Mina on 8th Dhil Hijjah.

8th Dhil Hijjah

- After Fajr prayer at Masjid al-Haram, pilgrims wear ihram, perform two rakats of Salah, and make the niyyah (intention) for Hajj.
- Pilgrims await instructions for transportation to Mina as per the schedule provided by Saudi authorities.
- Breakfast is served at the Pullman ZamZam Royal Clock Tower hotel before departure.
- Pilgrims depart for Mina and proceed to their designated tents according to the prescribed times.
- Upon arrival at the tents, pilgrims perform congregational Salah led by an imam within their respective tents.
- VIP buffet meals for lunch and dinner are provided throughout the stay in Mina.
- Educational sessions on various Islamic topics are conducted by a Mufti to enhance pilgrims' spiritual knowledge.
- The entire day is dedicated to worship (ibadah) and reflection, regarded as a blessed and significant day.
- Pilgrims prepare their luggage in advance for the next journey to Arafat.
- After Isha prayer, pilgrims move to Arafat tents following the timeline set by Saudi authorities.
- Pilgrims rest overnight in the Arafat tents to prepare for the following day's rituals.

9th Dhil Hijjah

- Upon arrival at Arafat, pilgrims rest in designated tents and are served breakfast. A period of rest follows until the time for Zuhr prayer.
- Prayer arrangements accommodate both major Islamic schools of thought:
 - Pilgrims following the Shafi'i school perform Zuhr and Asr prayers consecutively.
 - Pilgrims adhering to the Hanafi school perform Zuhr and Asr prayers separately at their respective prayer times.
 - Facilities are provided to support both prayer schedules.
- After a special buffet lunch at Arafat, all pilgrims gather to perform group prayer in the open air, in accordance with the Sunnah of the Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him).
- Sufficient time is allocated for pilgrims to engage in personal supplications (duas) until sunset.
- Dinner and water are packed and distributed to each pilgrim at Arafat, which they carry individually for the journey ahead.
- Pilgrims are advised to keep an adequate supply of water for their overnight stay at Muzdalifah, as no food or water will be available there during the night.
- Only toilet facilities are provided for pilgrims during the night at Muzdalifah.
- At sunset, pilgrims proceed to board buses, which depart after sunset towards Muzdalifah.
- Upon arrival at Muzdalifah, pilgrims perform Maghrib and Isha prayers consecutively, followed by time for dua.
- Afterwards, pilgrims partake in the ritual of pebble collection in preparation for the following day.
- Pilgrims then rest overnight, sleeping under the open sky in Muzdalifah.



10th Dhil Hijjah

- Pilgrims begin the day by performing the Fajr prayer at Muzdalifah, after which they proceed to board buses.
- Depending on crowd conditions and management, pilgrims are transported to the nearest accessible point for the Ramee of Jamarat (stoning of the pillars).
- Pilgrims perform the Ramee ritual and then return to the bus, which will drop them off as close as possible to their hotel, following Saudi authorities' guidelines.
- During the journey back to the hotel, the ritual of Qurbani (sacrificial offering) is performed on behalf of the pilgrims. Confirmation messages are sent to pilgrims once the sacrifice is completed.
- Upon return, pilgrims perform the Halaq, which involves men shaving their heads and women trimming their hair.
- Subsequently, all pilgrims perform the Tawaf al-Ziyarah (visitation circumambulation) at the Masjid al-Haram.
- After Tawaf, pilgrims rest at their hotel until nighttime.
- At night, pilgrims travel by bus to Mina for an overnight stay following dinner.
- Pilgrims return to their hotels before Fajr prayer and rest there.

11th Dhil Hijjah

- Pilgrims perform all obligatory prayers (Salaah) at Masjid al-Haram while residing at Pullman ZamZam Hotel, Makkah Clock Tower.
- The day is dedicated to rest, allowing pilgrims to recuperate.
- After Maghrib prayer, pilgrims have dinner.
- Following Isha prayer, pilgrims are transported to Jamarat to perform the ritual of Ramee (stoning of the pillars).
- Pilgrims then spend half the night in Mina.
- Before Fajr prayer, pilgrims return to the hotel.

12th Dhil Hijjah

- Pilgrims have breakfast at the hotel and rest until Zuhr prayer.
- After resting, pilgrims perform Zuhr prayer at Masjid al-Haram.
- Following Zuhr, pilgrims are transported to Jamarat to perform the ritual of Ramee (stoning of the pillars).
- After Ramee, pilgrims return to the hotel.
- Pilgrims perform all remaining prayers at Masjid al-Haram.
- Pilgrims are advised to prioritize rest for the remainder of the day.

- Pilgrims are encouraged to perform all prayers (Salaah) at Masjid al-Haram.
- Pilgrims may engage in shopping as needed to fulfill personal requirements.
- Time is allocated for packing and preparation for the return journey.
- After dinner, pilgrims perform Tawaf al-Wida (farewell circumambulation) at Masjid al-Haram during the night.

14th Dhil Hijjah

- Pilgrims perform Fajr prayer and have breakfast at the hotel.
- After breakfast, pilgrims depart for Jeddah Airport by bus.
- Care is taken to ensure all pilgrims begin their journey home safely, insha'Allah.



Terms & Conditions

1. General Conditions

- 1.1. Al Syed Tours International ("the Organizer") acts as a licensed Hajj Group Organizer (HGO) in providing travel and accommodation arrangements for pilgrims.
- 1.2. All pilgrimages are subject to the rules, regulations, and policies of the Hajj Ministry (KSA), local authorities (India), and relevant service providers/airlines/hotels.
- 1.3. The Organizer reserves the right to make changes in arrangements due to circumstances beyond its control (e.g., government orders, airline/transport schedule changes, force majeure events).
- 1.4 Packages are subject to change based on availability, regulations, airline schedules, and government directives.

2. Package Inclusions

- Flights: Return Hajj flight from Dubai Jeddah Dubai.
- Hajj Visa: One-time Hajj visa issuance for pilgrims.
- Accommodation:
 - Makkah: Zam Zam Pullman Hotel Half Board (Breakfast & Dinner included).
 - Madinah: Al Ansar Golden Tulip Hotel Full Board (Three daily meals).
- Transportation & Transfers:
 - Harmain High Speed Train transfer from Madinah to Makkah.
 - Private Al Syed Bus Service (group bus, seat-by-seat basis).
- During Hajj Days (Mina, Arafat, Muzdalifah):
 - Category A tents in Mina (Zone 1) with three buffet meals daily.
- · Other Services:
 - Group Accidental Insurance for all pilgrims.
 - · Government-issued Nusuk Smart Card (barcode enabled).
 - Guided Hajj coordination with group leaders.

3. Package Exclusions

- Qurbani (sacrifice).
- Any items/services not specifically listed under inclusions.
- Unexpected charges or surcharges levied by Saudi Government, airlines, or hotels.
- Personal expenses, medical costs outside group insurance coverage.





Terms & Conditions

4. Pricing Policy

- 4.1. All package prices quoted are exclusive of any government-imposed charges in GST (Non Refundable) & TCS (Refundable).
- 4.2. The prices mentioned in the brochure/booklet are introductory and applicable only for the initial group of pilgrims who confirm their bookings at an early stage.
- 4.3. As the Hajj season approaches, prices are subject to increase. This is due to the fact that, at later stages, organizational costs are financed through **financial institutions**, resulting in additional charges that will be reflected in the final package price.
- 4.4. In case of significant changes in airline fares, hotel rates, government schemes, or service requirements, any additional costs shall be borne by the pilgrim.
- 4.5. If the Saudi Government mandates upgrades from Category A tents to VIP buildings or similar compulsory changes, the additional cost will be payable by pilgrims.
- 4.6. Child fares are the same as adult fares.

5. Payments & Deadlines

- 5.1. Pilgrims must follow the **official payment schedule** provided by the Government.
- 5.2. Delays or non-compliance with payments may result in cancellation of seat without refund.
- 5.3. Only payments made directly to Al Syed Tours International (with official receipt) are valid. **No unauthorized payments to individuals are allowed.**

6. Cancellations & Refunds

- 6.1. No cancellations permitted after December 31, 2025.
- 6.2. Cancellations before this date will result in **deductions** as per actual costs, administrative charges, and airline/hotel penalties.
- 6.3. No refunds after Visa stamping under any circumstances.
- 6.4. Refund processing, if applicable, will take time and may be delayed due to third-party providers.

- 7.2. Pilgrims must comply with **all health, vaccination, and document requirements** set by the governments of Saudi Arabia and India
- . 7.3. Participation implies pilgrims are physically and mentally fit.

- 8.1. Insurance provided covers **accidental cases only**; extended medical coverage is the pilgrim's responsibility.
- 8.2. Pilgrims must travel together as per group coordination and respect HGO instructions to ensure safety.




